J Boat Fleet Racing Regatta June 1st, 2019 Cambridge, MD

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current edition

of Racing Rules of Sailing, as modified by Appendix E, the Sailing

instructions, and the J Boat class rules.

Eligibility: The regatta is open to all who are sailing a properly registered and

measured J Boat. All boats are subject to inspection at any time during or

after the regatta.

Racing will continue with no race start after 3pm Saturday Dinner will be at Snapper's Restaurant

The race committee reserves the right to alter the schedule and make

verbal changes to the Sailing Instructions as necessary.

Course Area: Racing will take place in the tidal water off the Cambridge Yacht Club.

Unless you fall off the dock, this should be a dry launch location.

Fleet Management: The race management system to be used will be determined based on fleet

size and local conditions.

Scoring The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.

Race Course: The preferred course will be a two lap windward/leeward course.

Starts: The start tape will be 2 minutes in length. Boats are competing at the 1

minute mark.

Only the RD may call a boat over early (On the Course Side-OCS). Any boat found OCS must round either end of the start line and restart. A boat

found OCS that does not return will be scored DNS.

Penalty Turns: A penalty turn will be a 360 degree turn. In accordance with current rules,

you shall continue to do turns until any advantage gained is lost. If you

cause a boat to retire, you shall retire also.

Throwouts: One throw out for the regatta after three races.

Holds: A skipper may request a 5 minute hold BEFORE the one-minute mark of the

start sequence. Only one 5 minute hold per boat per day is allowed.

Awards: Trophies will be awarded after racing to the top five (5) finishers.
